

BY-LAWS

1. Secretary. It shall be the duty of the secretary to keep the constitution and by-laws of the club and have the same with him at every meeting. He shall cause all amendments changes and additions to be noted thereon and shall permit the same to be consulted by members upon request.
2. Membership. Full membership is open to licensed amateurs and those actively engaged in a class leading to an amateur radio license. Associate membership is open to all other interested persons, including family of members. A full membership includes all club privileges as well as rights to hold an elected club office and to vote for club officers and motions brought before the club for action. Associate membership includes all club privileges except to hold office and to vote at club meetings.
3. Meetings. Meetings shall be held regularly on a day and at a place determined by a majority of those present at a regular meeting of the club. Special meetings may be called by the President upon the written request of any five club members. Notice shall be given to members concerning the special meetings and the business to be transacted. Such notices shall be so given that they are communicated to the members not less than 24 hours before the meeting time. The notification shall be made to each member by the president or the secretary, who shall certify that all voting members were notified. Certification may be by a list of members contacted, and shall become a part of club records kept in the minutes. This notification may be by U.S. Postal Mail, E-Mail or telephone (landline or cell phone) or by amateur radio or in person. Only such business as designated shall be transacted at special meetings.
4. Dues. A regular yearly assessment of \$5.00 per member and \$7.50 per family is hereby assessed in accordance with the provisions of Article V of the Constitution for the purpose of providing funds for current expenses. The \$7.50 family dues shall be in effect whether or not the included family member(s) hold valid amateur radio licenses. In cases where more than one family member holds a valid amateur radio license, all licensed family members will be considered full members as described in by-law no. 2.
5. Election of Officers. The election of officers shall take place at the first club meeting of the calendar year, and the officers so elected shall assume office at that meeting immediately upon their election. See article II, Sec. 2 of club constitution.
